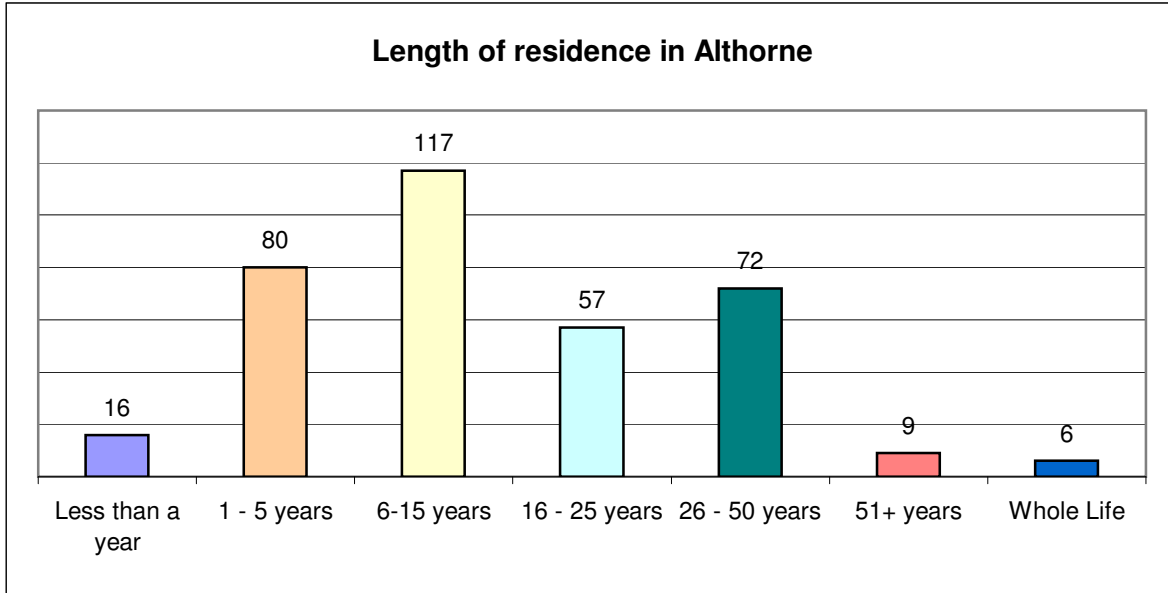

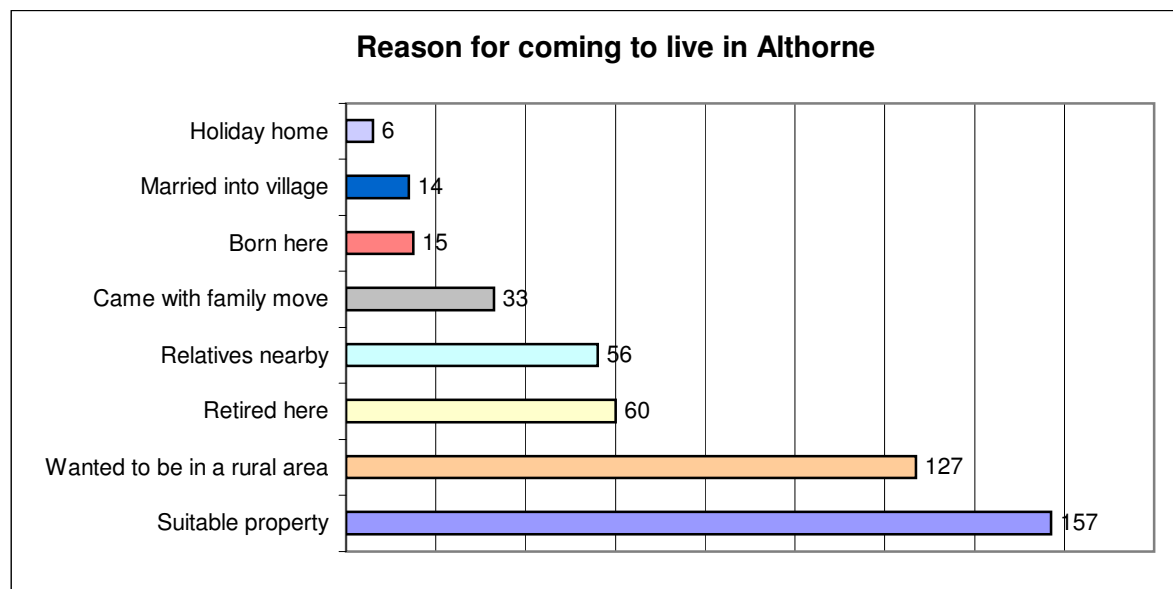

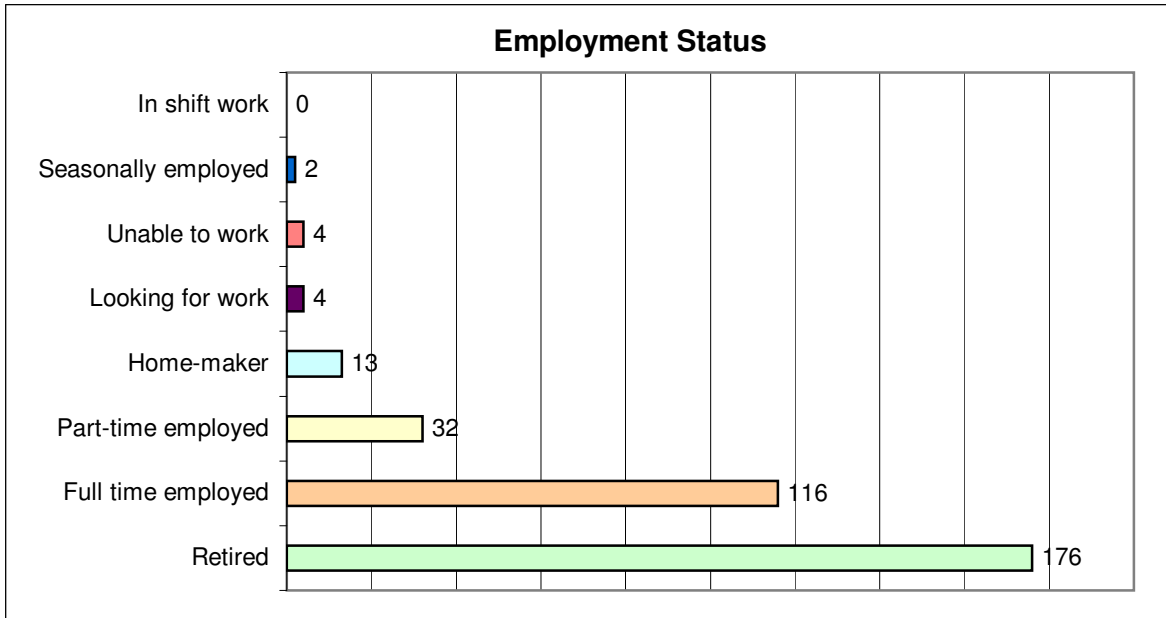
Q7 *What one place, building or feature in Althorne do you find most attractive?*

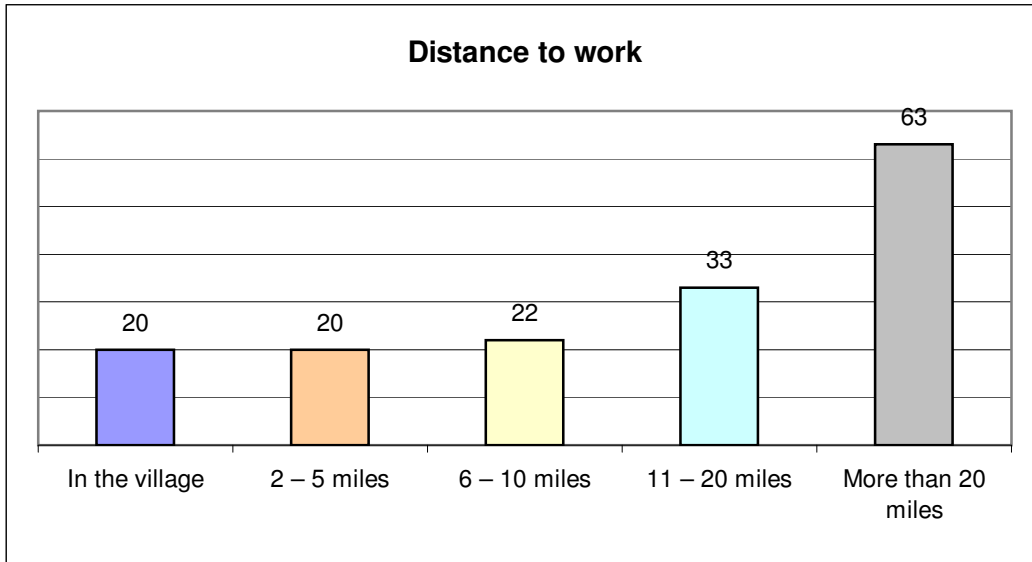

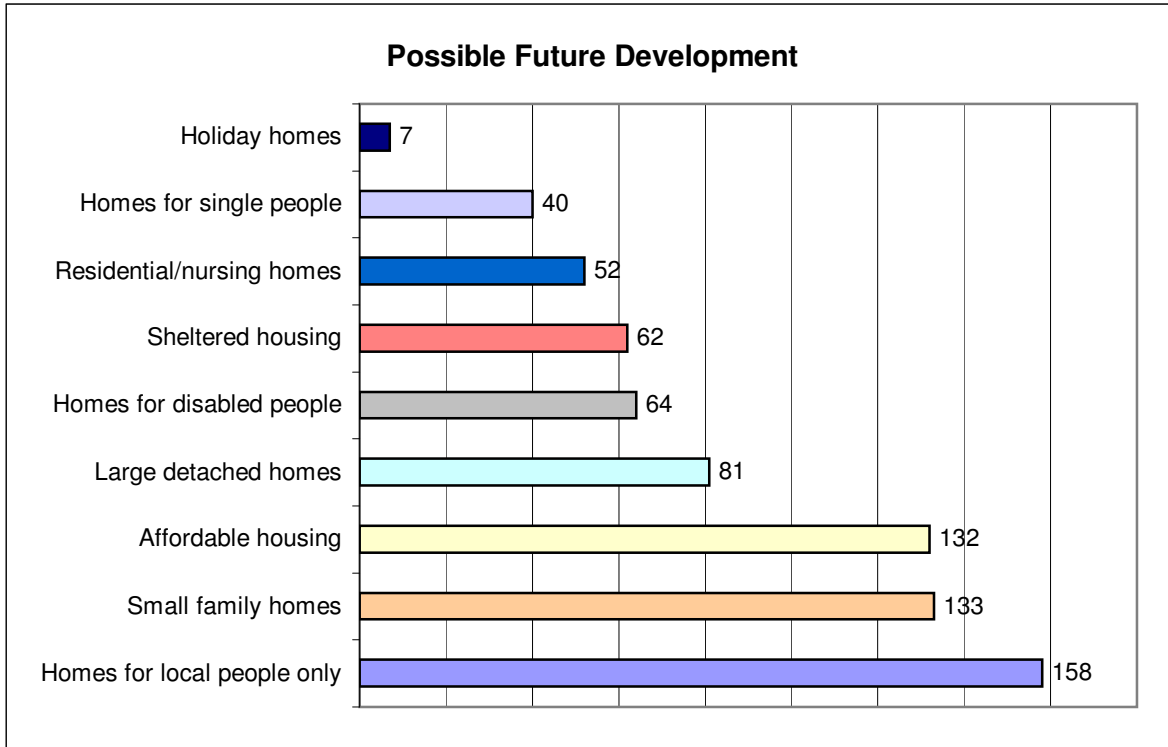

Q16 *If development takes place in Althorne, which of the following would be preferable?*

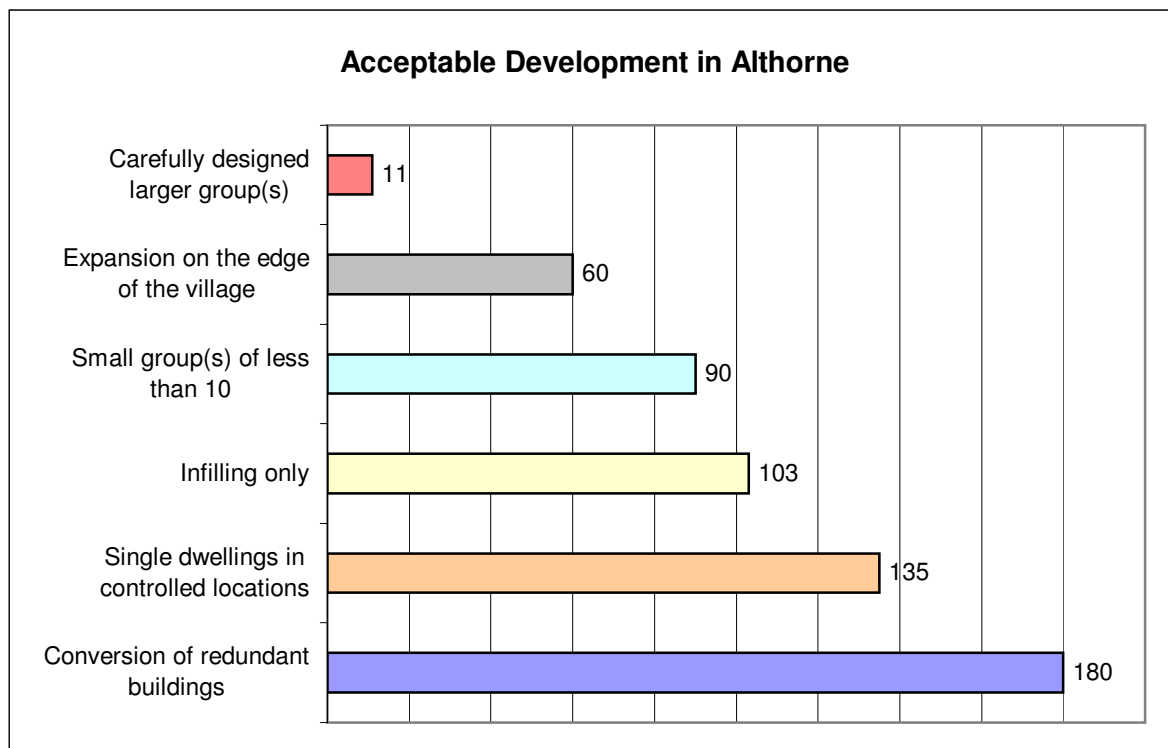

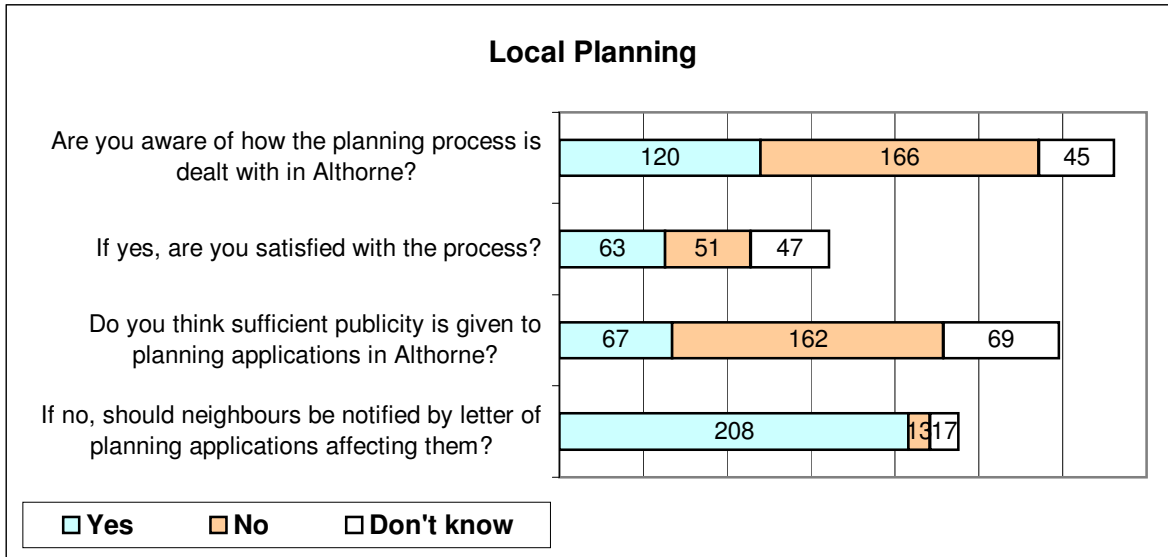

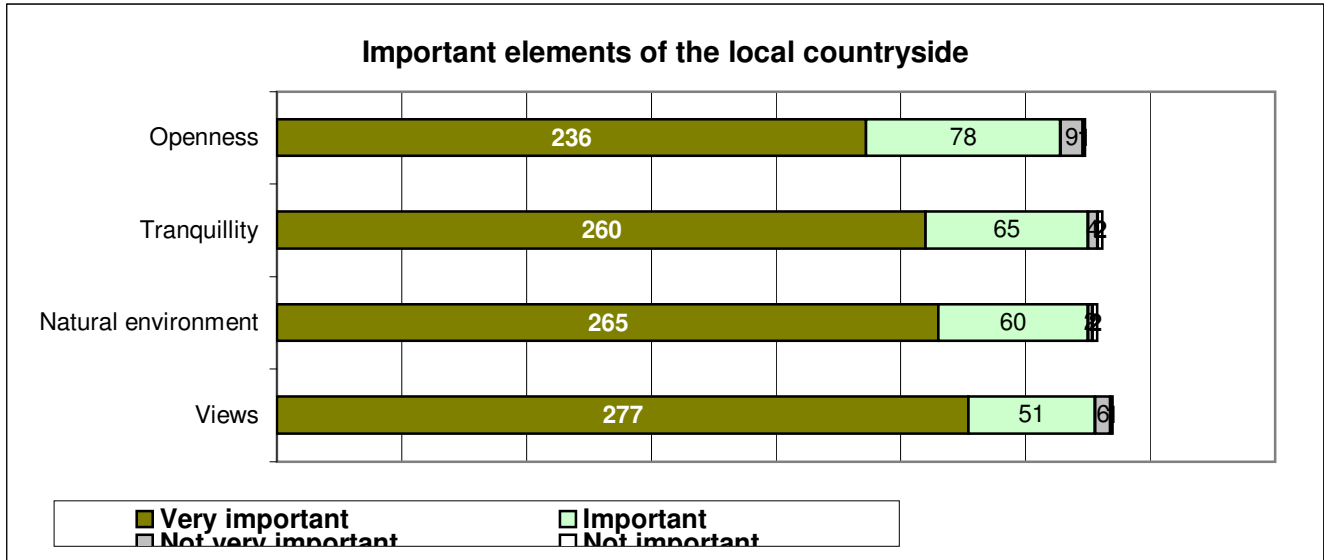

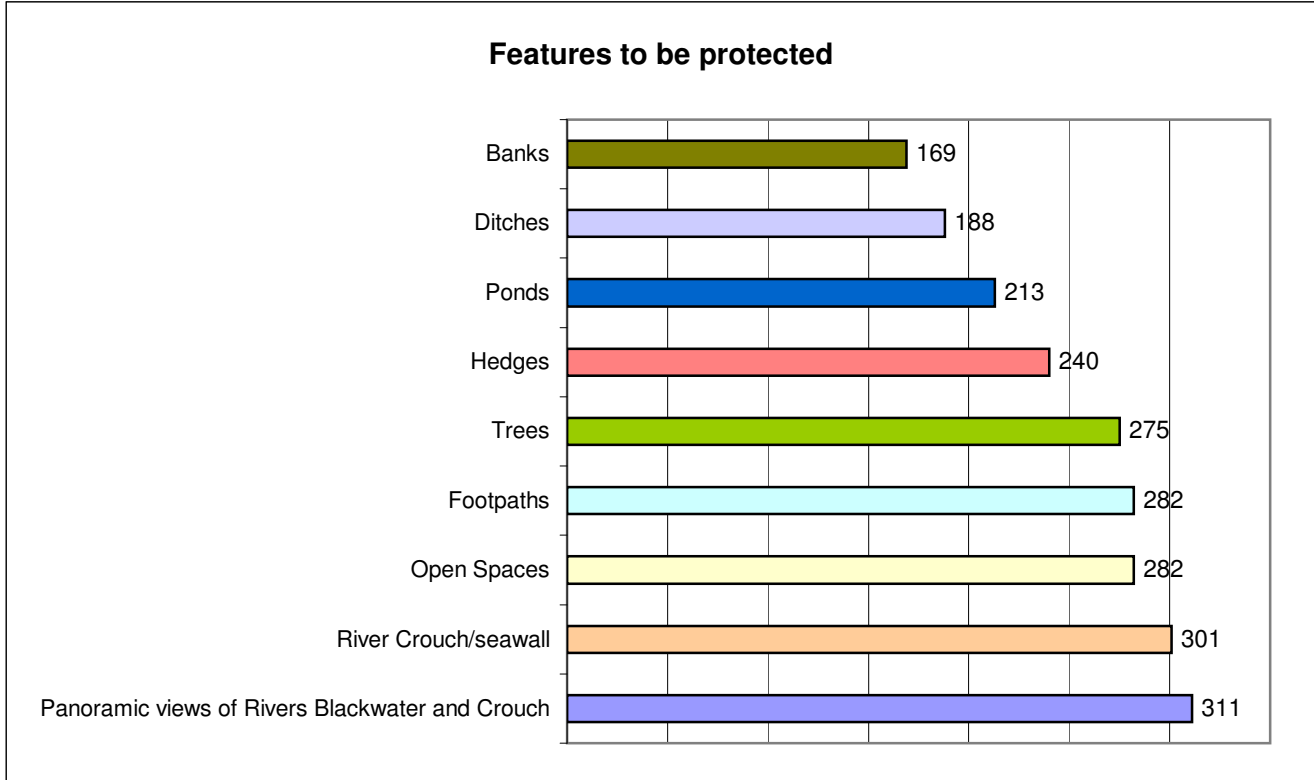

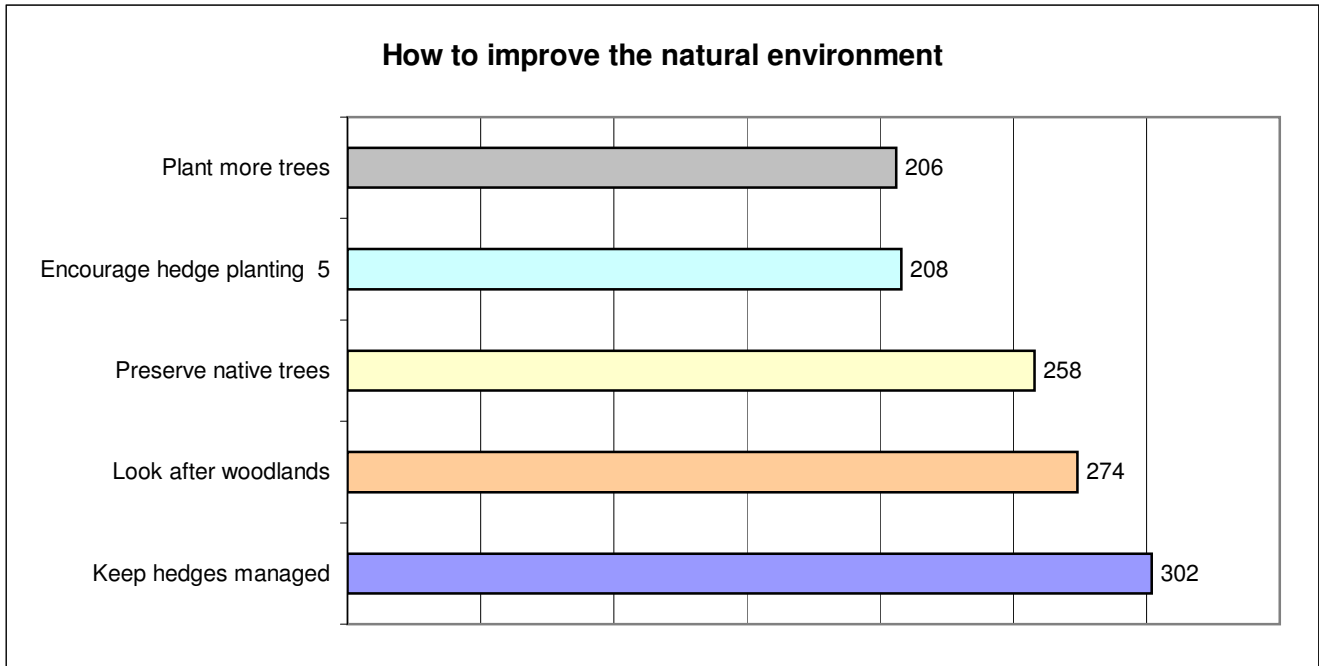

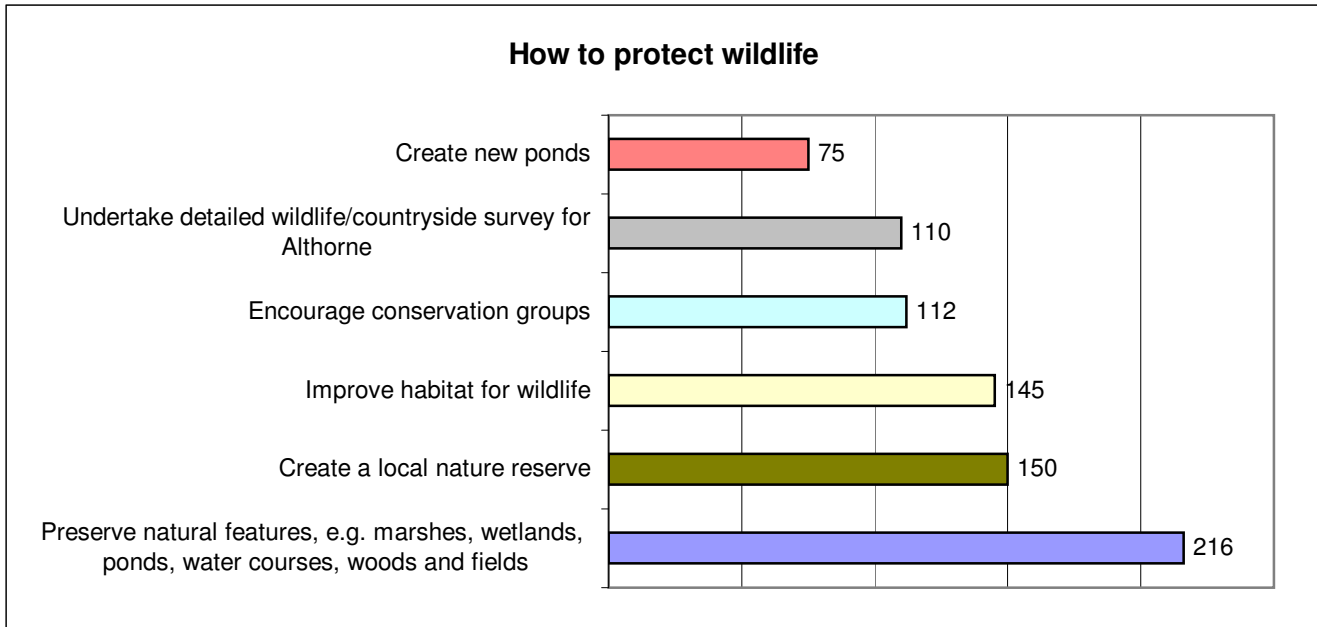

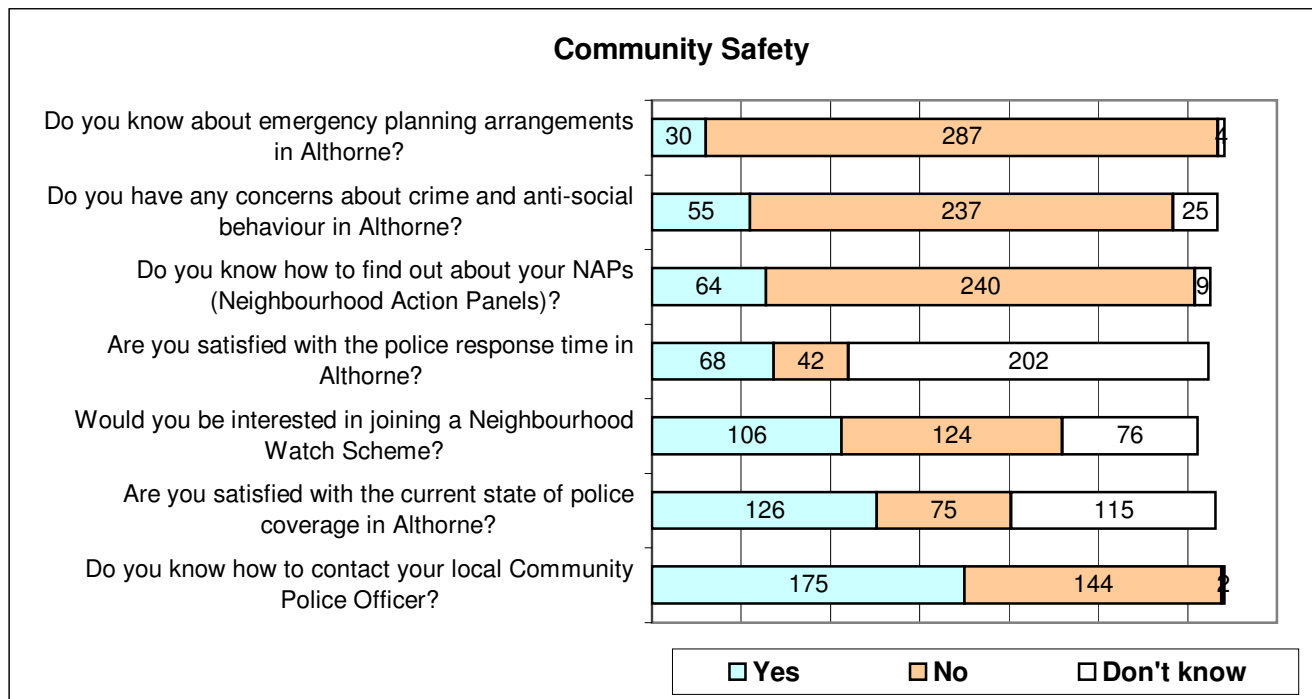

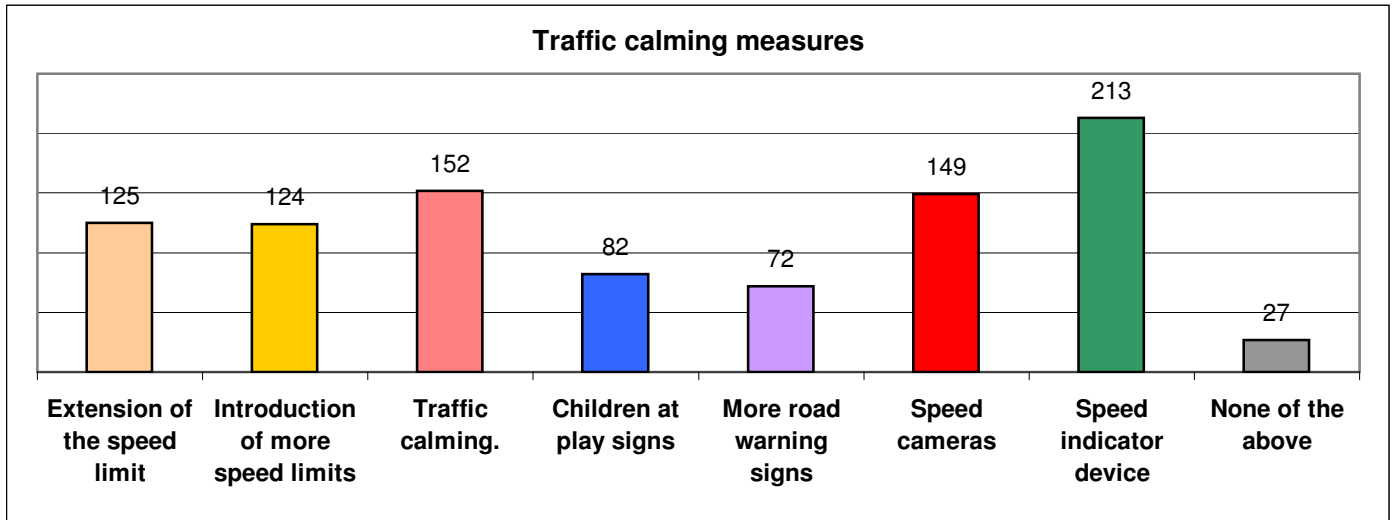

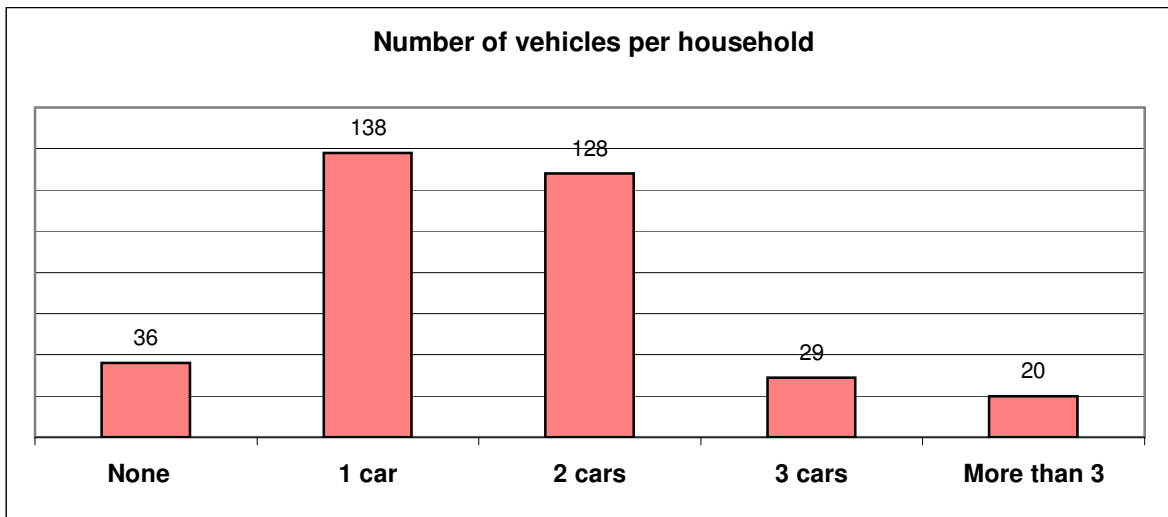

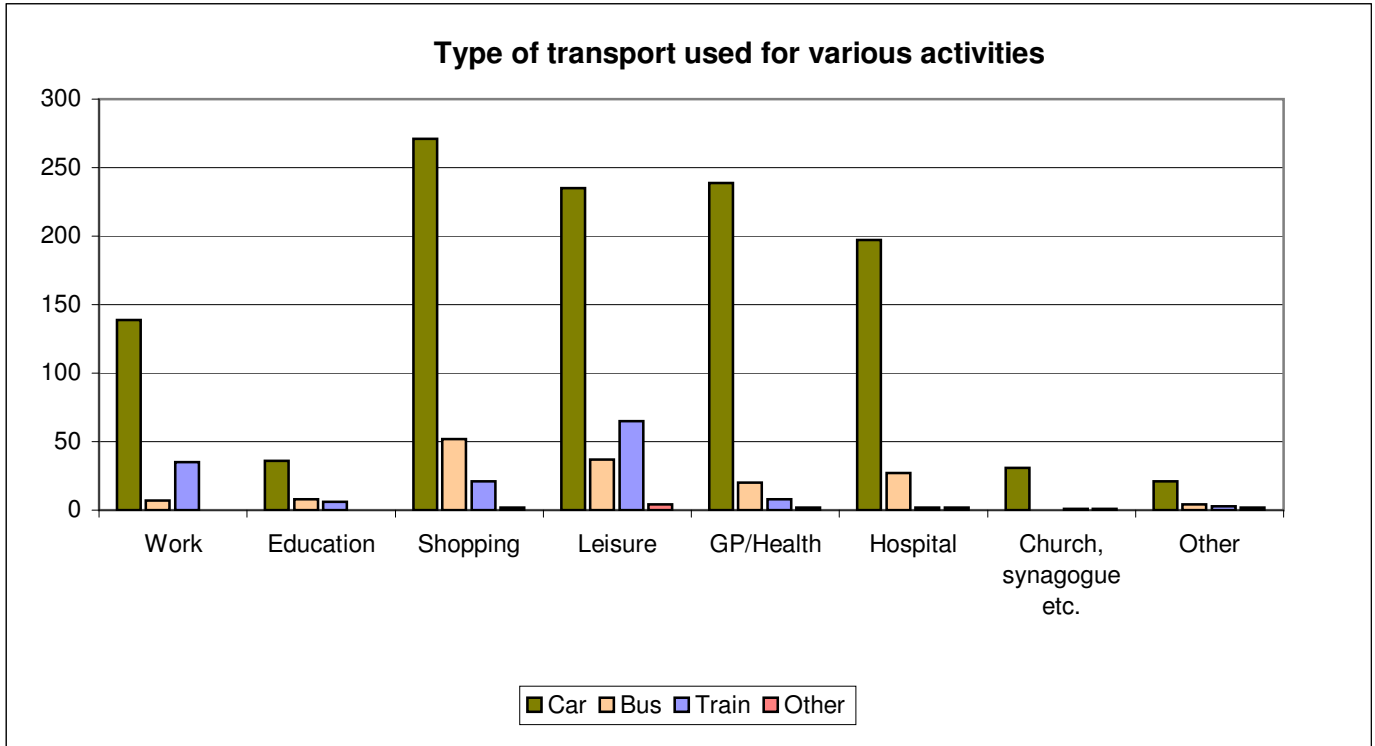

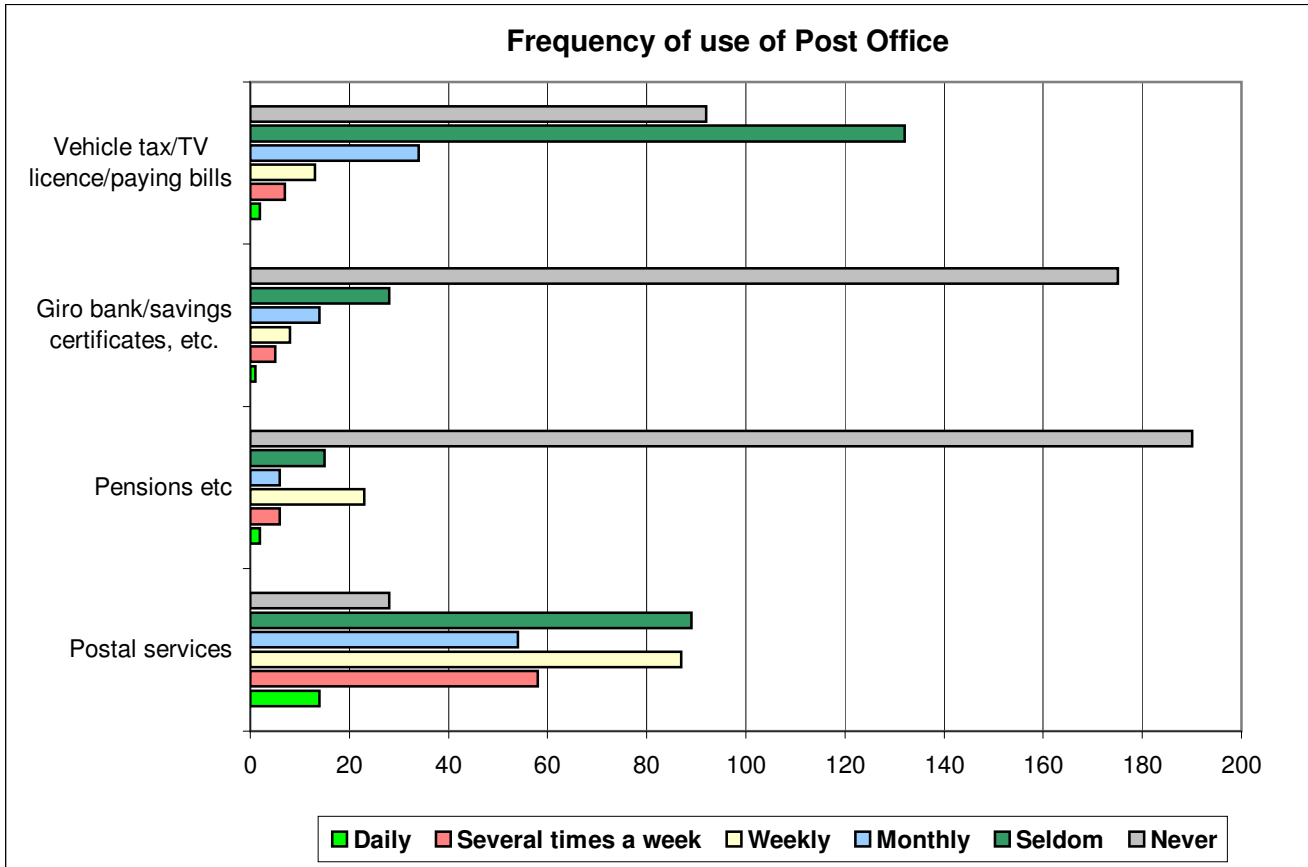

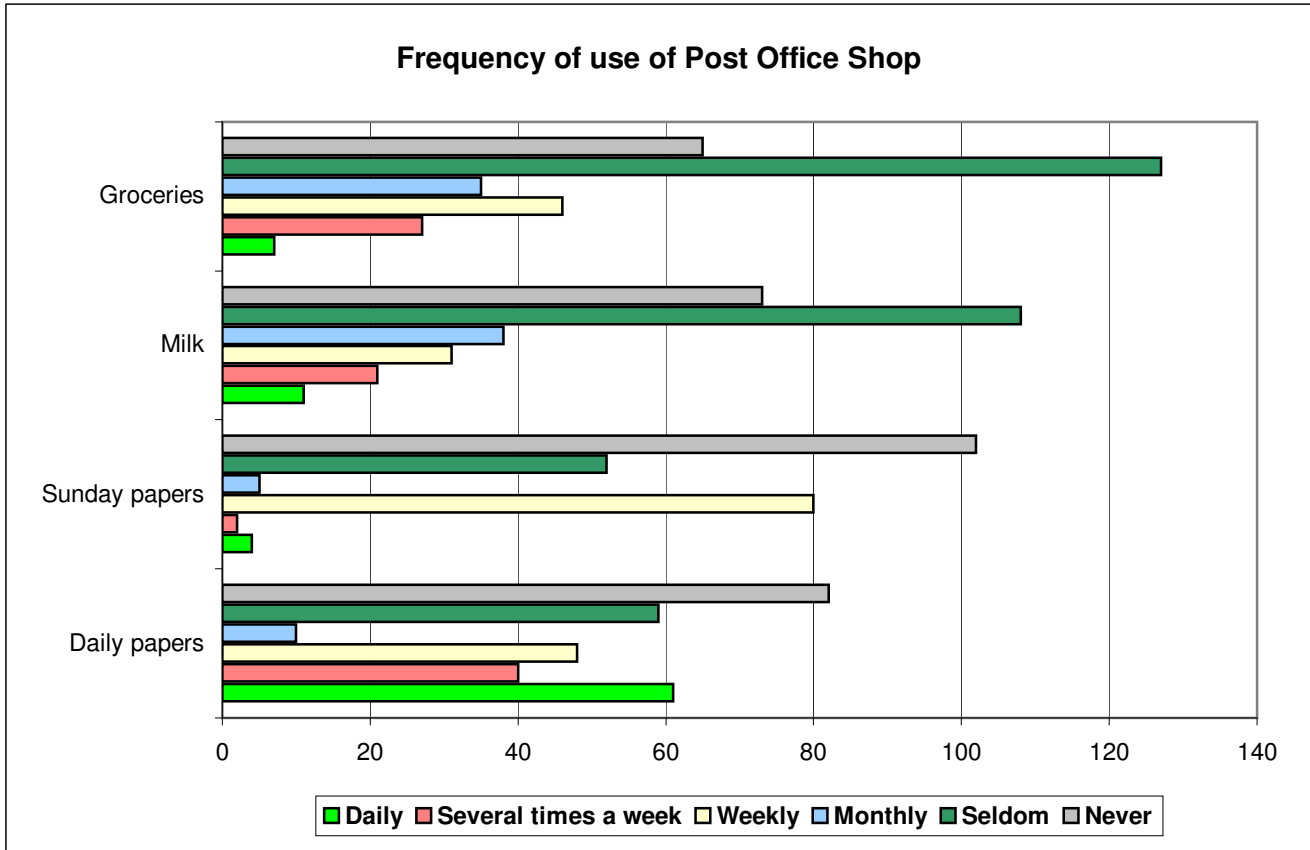

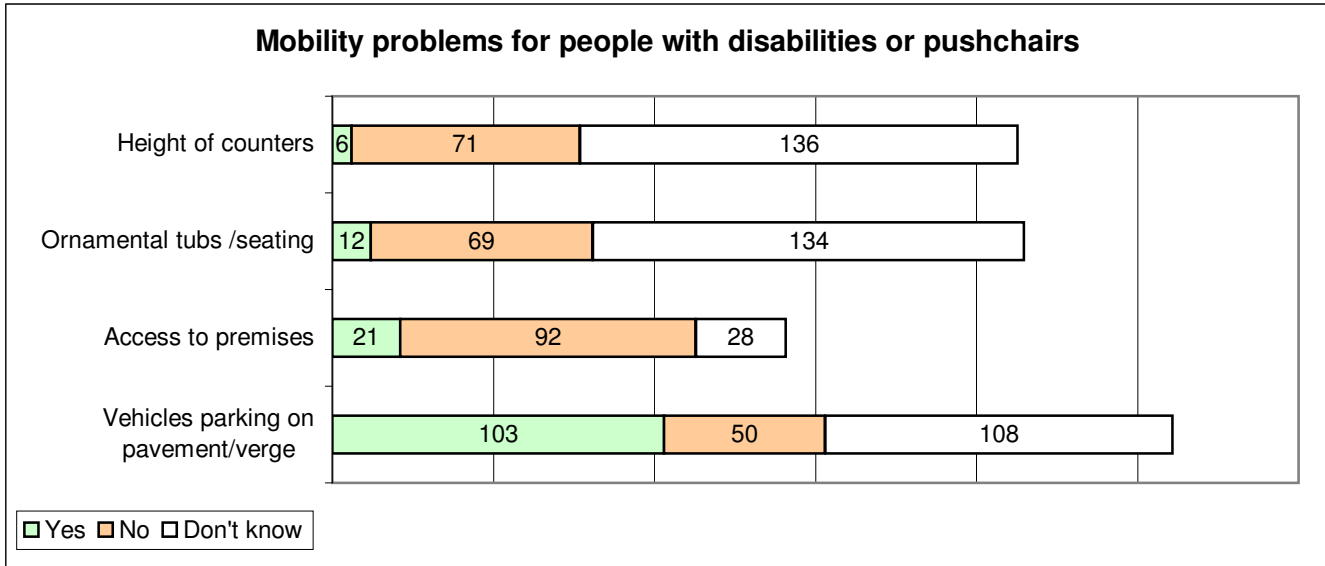
